## High School Teams – Membership Terms

### Team Membership Includes:

- ❖ Membership and Affiliation with a nationally recognized rowing club with strong ties and influence with the rowing, local, and regional communities.
- ❖ Use of club facilities and equipment: boathouse, showers/restrooms, docks, boats, trailers, ergs, repair bay and repair assistance, winter conditioning site, etc. (*certification is required for certain boats*)
- ❖ Boat, oar, erg, launch, and supply storage area for your team.
- ❖ Designated Team Area and Team Mural on your team door.
- ❖ US Rowing membership, USRowing regatta entries, and liability coverage under the TRC blanket.
- ❖ TRC provides CPR/first aid training in the spring of every year.
- ❖ TRC provides USRowing coaches certification for (Levels I, II, & III where applicable) to coaches who have been a TRC member for at least one year. Additional clinics and training are also offered. TRC reimburses the cost of the certification only.
- ❖ Input and participation in monthly TRC meetings, including budget input, rules of membership, etc.
- ❖ Opportunity to fundraise and receive membership dues credits for participating in the Frogtown Regatta.
- ❖ Active Team Coaches (in good standing) enjoy full TRC membership privileges.
- ❖ Active HS Team members (in good standing) enjoy full access to TRC membership privileges.

### Team Member Expectations:

- ❖ Have your TRC waivers, membership information, and payments submitted to the club complete and on time. (*Deadlines are: Spring April 15, Fall August 15*)
- ❖ No team member or coach is permitted at the boathouse without a signed TRC waiver on file. (*No exceptions*)
- ❖ All coaches (head, assistants, and volunteer) must be CPR/first aid certified.
- ❖ Participate/attend in any mandatory TRC Safety or informational meetings designated by the TRC board.
- ❖ Maintain a clean, SAFE, and organized boathouse.
- ❖ All members are to demonstrate good behavior, good sportsmanship, respect for each other, and care and respect for all property and equipment.
- ❖ Abide by TRC Safety Policy, the TRC Coldwater Operations Guidelines, and the TRC Safety Launch Required Equipment Policy.
- ❖ Abide by all USRowing membership rules, guidelines, or directives.
- ❖ High School Teams are expected to provide their own equipment for practices and races. TRC equipment is only to be used in an emergency, equipment breakdown, or when team growth exceeds current equipment inventory on a temporary basis. TRC equipment is not to be used simply because it is newer or in better condition.
- ❖ HS Novice Rowers are NOT permitted to use any TRC equipment (shells).
- ❖ When using any TRC equipment, teams must log in/log out of the TRC logbook. You are financially responsible for TRC equipment when in use by your team.
- ❖ Participate in scheduled boathouse cleanups, docks in, and docks out.
- ❖ Support and participate in the annual Frogtown Regatta races.
- ❖ Report damaged equipment, acts of vandalism, sexual harassment, or any behavior/actions that are detrimental to the club. (To the TRC President)
